Award Categories

These awards recognise community spirit and provide role models for all Australians. They help us appreciate the depth of individual and group achievement in our community over the last 12 months.

- **Citizen of the Year**
 - Must be 25 years of age or over at 26 January 2020.
- **Young Citizen of the Year**
 - Must be younger than 25 years of age at 26 January 2020.
- **Community Event/Organisation of the Year**
 - Community organisations/events that have made a significant contribution or exceptional achievement.
- **Senior Sports Award**
 - Must be 18 years of age or over at 26 January 2020.
- **Dave Watt Memorial Junior Sports Award**
 - Must be less than 18 years of age at 26 January 2020.
- **Sports Administrator Award**
 - Persons who have a noteworthy record of achievement in Sport or have made a significant contribution as a coach, official, mentor trainer or administrator.
- **Cultural Award**
 - Persons who have made a noteworthy contribution to the cultural life of the community or have made an outstanding achievement in cultural activity/activities.
- **Achievement Award (4 only)**
 - Person or organisations that have made a significant contribution or exceptional achievement in a chosen field.
- **Southern Gulf NRM Sarus Crane Awards**
 - The nominee can be any individual or group who either live or operate in the Southern Gulf region and who have been active in Natural Resource Management within 12 months.
 - A person or group who have made a significant contribution to sustainable natural resources management or the environment.

Criteria

- Nominee **MUST** be a resident of the Cloncurry Shire.
- Nominations may be submitted by groups (for example, committees, associations, schools and so on) or individuals, with or without the knowledge of the persons being nominated.
- The nature of the Citizen Awards places emphasis on what the person has/had done for the community in their various fields of involvement, rather than:
 - recognising personal achievements and/or ambitions (except where the personal achievement has brought recognition to the Cloncurry community and has engendered community pride), or
 - what they may have done as part of the normal duties in their occupation (except where the nominee's achievements are above and beyond what is expected in an individual's normal duties).
- Awards will not be granted posthumously.
- Self-nominations will not be accepted.
- Nominees must comply with the age restrictions specified in 'award categories'.
- Unsuccessful nominees may be re-nominated in subsequent years.
- Uncompleted forms or short sentence wording will not be accepted.

- Personal, academic, sporting and professional achievements, awards and recognition
- Contribution in the relevant field (how has the nominee 'put back' into their field to benefit others)
- Demonstrated leadership, innovation and creativity
- Future goals and likely impact
- Nature and length of activity or service
- Achievements as an individual or as part of a group or organisation
