

Sheaffe Street Roundabout Monument – Connection to our History

Terms & Conditions of Design Competition

This competition is conducted by Cloncurry Shire Council, 38-46 Daintree Street, Cloncurry, Queensland 4824 (**Cloncurry Shire Council**).

By participating in Cloncurry Shire Council's "Sheaffe Street Roundabout Well Monument" design competition (**Competition**) in Australia, you (**Entrant**) agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.

If you do not accept these terms and conditions, you cannot participate in the Competition or be eligible for any prizes offered in the Competition.

Competition Period

1. Entries into the Competition open on 7 February 2022 at 12:01am AEST and close on 25 March 2022 at 11:59pm AEST (**Competition Period**).
2. Following the Competition, the following judging period will be completed in the following manner:
 - Shortlisting (selection of each judge's top three entries in each section): Thursday 31 March 2022 by 11:59pm AEST.
 - Judging: 5 April 2022 by 11:59pm AEST.
 - Prize announcement: 28 April 2022.

Eligibility

Student Program

3. The Student Program section of the competition is only open to individuals under 18 years of age (as at competition close date) and are Australian citizens, permanent residents or Australian passport holders living in Australia. The individual must also be enrolled in a Cloncurry School to be eligible for the competition. Eligible schools in Cloncurry include Cloncurry State School, St. Joseph's Catholic School Cloncurry, Mount Isa School of the Air (where students must be located in the Cloncurry Shire Local Government Area). An application may be submitted from an individual or as part of a team. Team members must all meet the individual requirements of being under 18 and enrolled in a Cloncurry School.

Open Program

4. The Open Program section of the competition is only open to individuals over 18 years of age (as at competition close date) and are Australian citizens, permanent residents or Australian passport holders living in Australia. An application may be submitted from an individual or as part of a team. Team members must all meet the individual requirements of being over 18.

Entries

A person may enter the Competition by:

- (a) accessing one of Cloncurry Shire Council's entry forms available from www.cloncurry.qld.gov.au/ and
- (b) submitting a completed entry form via email in the format described below to the dedicated email address at council@cloncurry.qld.gov.au or in person at 38-46 Daintree Street, Cloncurry Qld 4824. All details on the form must be completed and valid for the entry to be eligible. In exceptional circumstances, Cloncurry Shire Council may consider entries made by any other means.

A person may enter the Competition in accordance with these terms and conditions on more than one occasion, although Cloncurry Shire Council reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to refuse to accept multiple entries from an Entrant.

Formatting, style, and contents of design entry

5. Entries may be submitted via email or in person and must be submitted observing the following formatting and stylistic elements:
 - (a) electronic applications must be in a viewable document and of a high resolution in one of the below files:
 - Word (.docx, .doc)
 - PDF file
 - JPEG
 - PNG
6. Entries that are deemed by the judges to be works of plagiarism will be disqualified. Entries must not contain any dedications
7. Entries must not contain anything unlawful, defamatory, libellous or obscene. Entries containing anything which Cloncurry Shire Council, or the judges deem inappropriate will be disqualified.

Prize

8. The prizes are as follows:
 - (a) Student Program
 - first prize to student submission, the winner of which will receive \$500 Cloncurry Gift Card
 - School of the winning individual/team submission will receive a \$1,000 Cloncurry Gift Card
 - (b) Open Program
 - first prize, the winner of which will receive \$1,000 Cloncurry Gift Card
 - second prize, the winner of which will receive \$500 Cloncurry Gift Card
 - third prize, the winner of which will receive \$250 Cloncurry Gift Card
 - (c) Final Design for Installation
 - The final design winner (of which the design will developed to be used to install the monument) will be chosen from the first prize winner of the Student Program and first prize winner of the Open Program
9. Prizes will be delivered to participants within 30 days of Cloncurry Shire Council announcing the winners and receiving confirmation of the delivery address.

Judging

10. All entries will be judged by a Judging Panel, who will have the necessary expertise required to assess the artwork designs.
11. In the event of a tie or no clear first place winner a tie break will be decided at the discretion of the Cloncurry Shire Council Councillors.
12. The Judging Panel's decision is also final. Each entry will be individually judged based on the Judging Criteria:
 - a. Judging Criteria:
 - i. Student Program:
 1. Communicate your design to the judges: project concept description (20%)
 2. Demonstrate your concept: design sketch (20%)
 3. Demonstrate the intent of design: clearly indicate important design details (20%)
 4. Demonstrate your understanding of local history and context (20%)
 5. Demonstrate design feasibility for the location and community engagement (20%)
 - ii. Open Program:
 1. Communicate your design to the judges: project concept description (20%)
 2. Demonstrate your concept: design sketch (20%)
 3. Demonstrate the intent of design: clearly indicate important design details (20%)
 4. Demonstrate your understanding of local history and context (20%)
 5. Demonstrate design feasibility for the location and community engagement (20%)
13. Shortlisted contestants/teams may be invited to showcase their projects to the Judging Panel on Tuesday 5 April 2022.
14. The Judges final design winner will be subject to engineering design to ensure that design does not compromise the safety of the road users. Council, in consultation with the judges and winning entrant, will progress the engineering process to ensure the winning design will meet the necessary engineering design requirements prior to the installation of the monument.
15. Entries must be received before the end of the Competition Period to be considered.
16. Cloncurry Shire Council accepts no responsibility for any entries not received within the required time or at all. Entries will be deemed accepted when they are received by Cloncurry Shire Council.
17. Cloncurry Shire Council may verify the validity of entries and disqualify any Entrant without notice for providing false information, failing to comply with these terms and conditions or tampering with the entry process.
18. Cloncurry Shire Council is not responsible for any technical difficulties which prevent an otherwise valid entry from being received by Cloncurry Shire Council.
19. The competition winners will be announced on Thursday 28 April 2022.
20. All winners will be announced by social media and broadcast media after winners have been individually notified.
21. The winner will be contacted by phone and email. If the winner cannot be contacted by Cloncurry Shire Council within one week of judging, Cloncurry Shire Council may select an alternative entry as the winner.

22. If a winner is disqualified or deemed ineligible in accordance with these terms of entry or a prize remains unclaimed after 14 days, and after reasonable efforts have been made by Cloncurry Shire Council to contact a winner, the winner forfeits the prize and Cloncurry Shire Council reserves the right to award the prize to the next-ranked Entrant as determined by Cloncurry Shire Council in its sole discretion. The substitute winner, if any, will be notified via email and published on the Cloncurry Shire Council website.
23. Council reserves the right to use any of the submitted designs for alternative locations in the Cloncurry Shire.

Media/Promotions

24. All prize winners agree to participate in media activities requested by Cloncurry Shire Council in Cloncurry Shire Council's discretion.
25. By entering the competition, applicants agree to let Cloncurry Shire Council use entrants' submissions for promotional purposes, educational resources, and the promotion of future design competitions.

Liability

26. Subject to paragraph 28, Cloncurry Shire Council will not be liable for any loss or damage (however caused), suffered by the Entrant in connection with these terms and conditions or the Competition.
27. Except as contemplated by paragraph 28, nothing in these terms and conditions is intended to limit any rights of the Entrant under the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth).
28. The winner is solely responsible for all government charges, expenses, taxes or any other tax or duty payable in connection with the prize.

Intellectual property and personal information

29. Each Entrant makes the following warranties to Cloncurry Shire Council:
 - (a) All submissions and presentations provided to Cloncurry Shire Council and the judging panels during the course of the Competition (**Work** or **Works**) are the Entrant's own work.
 - (b) The Works do not infringe the rights of any third party, including, without limitation, intellectual property rights and moral rights.
30. By entering the Competition, the Entrant consents to Cloncurry Shire Council using, modifying and disclosing:
 - (a) the Entrant's name, likeness, image or voice (including photograph, film or recording) in any media; and
 - (b) all information provided by the Entrant in the entry form (**Material**),

for an unlimited time without further reference, payment, or any other compensation to the Entrant for the promotion of any products or services of Cloncurry Shire Council, including sending the Entrant electronic messages.
31. The use and disclosure of the Material by Cloncurry Shire Council is subject to Cloncurry Shire Council's privacy policy and the restrictions imposed by the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth). A copy of Cloncurry Shire Council's privacy policy is available on our www.cloncurry.qld.gov.au/.
32. If an Entrant does not provide Cloncurry Shire Council with the personal information requested in the entry form, then Cloncurry Shire Council may, in its absolute discretion, disqualify the Entrant from the Competition.
33. The Entrant agrees to assign all rights, title, and interest in the Intellectual Property to Cloncurry Shire Council on the terms and conditions set out in this document.
