Sir Hudson Fysh Drive Works Update

Cloncurry Shire Council wishes to advise that the PRIME has gone down today, 19 April 2023, on Sir Hudson Fysh Drive. This will be followed by the SEAL going down on Saturday, 22 April 2023, which will be the final step in the rectification works.

Sir Hudson Fysh Drive will remain closed to traffic. It is critical that no vehicles drive over the PRIME/SEAL until the road is opened. Driving on the unset seal will not only cause significant damage to the road but also to vehicles that drive on it. Traffic controllers will be on-site enforcing the following road conditions that will be implemented until final works are finished.

Date	Roads/Assets Impacted	Road conditions




Figure 1: Sir Hudson Fysh Drive Road Closure

19 – 23 April 2023	Sir Hudson Fysh Drive (Between Carl Katter Bridge and Alice Street)	Closed to all traffic. Traffic management enforced. Refer to Figure 1. *Prior arrangements with impacted businesses will continue as agreed.
	Cemetery	Works will restrict access to the Cemetery, alternative access will be via Henry Street.
