- Remember to keep a copy of your application and/or lists of enclosures for financial acquittal purposes.
- Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

| Grant Category and Description | Maximum |

| Community Activities/Events Development <i>Grants are offered under this category to assist organisations with the planning and development of local community events that will assist in building community capacity and promoting community cohesion. If your event is an annual event to raise money for charity, it is expected that sufficient funds would be retained to cover expenses for the following year.</i> | \$5,000 |
| Community Activities/Events Development e.g. Curry Merry Muster Festival, Stockman’s Challenge and Campdraft, Cloncurry and District Show <i>As per above description for Community Activities/Events Developments.</i> | >\$5000 |
| Sport and Recreation Development <i>A grant under this category is for the support of community-based sporting organisations/associations in the development of sport and recreation projects and activities for residents in the Cloncurry region. Capital purchases deemed necessary for the development, support or administration of the proposed sporting activity may also be submitted under this category.</i> | \$5,000 |
| Community Cultural Development <i>The aim of the Community Cultural Development Grant is to develop the capacity of local groups to broaden the opportunities that may be available to participate in cultural activities.</i> | \$5,000 |
| Activities contributing to the Economic Vitality of Cloncurry <i>This category is to encourage activities, other than those in previous categories that can be seen to be contributing to the economic viability of the area. For example: a contribution towards a one-off event that attracts a high number of visitors to the area.</i> | \$5,000 |
| Small Equipment <i>The small equipment category is to provide financial assistance for the purchase of equipment which will support the development of the organisation or its volunteers. For example: computers, office equipment or kitchen appliances etc.</i> | \$1,000 |
| Community Printing and In Kind Assistance Program <i>Open to non-profit club of organisation located in Cloncurry Shire. The purpose is to provide reproduction of programs, agendas, reports, newsletters or use of small equipment items i.e. portable PA, whiteboard, tables, chairs, lectern.</i> | Up to value of \$200 |
| Local Training Bursary <i>A financial contribution towards travel and accommodation to participate in training courses/workshops that will provide direct benefit back to the Cloncurry Shire community, whether be Sport and Recreation, Arts and Culture were an applicant may not be able to access an existing bursary may not be available. Applicants will be required to demonstrate how their training will benefit the community i.e. introduce a new activity or pursuit for local residents. This is to be included in the application form.</i> | Up to \$1000 |
| Bursary (local) <i>A financial contribution to a local school or educational facility based in Cloncurry Shire that supports or recognises achievement of a student under the age of 18.</i> | \$100 |
| Bursary (State) <i>A financial contribution towards travel and associated costs related to representing Cloncurry Shire at a State (or above) level in their chosen sport/activity.</i> | \$250 |
| Bursary (National) <i>A financial contribution towards travel and associated costs related to representing Cloncurry Shire at a State (or above) level in their chosen sport/activity.</i> | \$500 |
