Cloncurry Shire Council would like to advise that rate notices are expected to start arriving in mailboxes from 4 February 2026. **If you have not received your rates notice by Monday, 23 February 2026, please contact Council on (07) 4742 4100 or council@cloncurry.qld.gov.au.** Council must receive payments before 5:00pm on Wednesday, 11 March 2026, for the Prompt Payment Discount to apply.

ARE YOUR DETAILS UP TO DATE?

It is important to keep your contact details up to date with Council to ensure you receive your rates and water consumption notices. These notices are posted or emailed to the last known address registered with Council at the time of issue. It is the property owner's responsibility to notify Council in writing via the applicable form of any changed contact details.

You can notify Council about changed contact details by completing the [Update Personal Details Form](#), found at Council's Administration Office or on Council's website. Please complete the form and return to Council either in person at the Administration Office, via email, or via post.

Council can send ratepayers their notices via email. If you would like to receive your notices via email in the future, please complete the [Update Personal Details Form](#). Council must receive your request in writing via the applicable form to be able to send notices via email.




