COUNCIL PROJECTS

SCARR STREET REDEVELOPMENT

Works on the Scarr Street project are currently progressing on schedule, with Stage 1 in-ground services works now largely complete. This stage has been formally handed over to Auzcott Construction, who will now progress the completion of associated surface works, including footpaths, kerbing, and awning footings.

Stage 2 construction activities are currently underway. These works include demolition activities and the installation of new infrastructure services. Works are being delivered in a staged manner to manage impacts and maintain safety across the site.

Council will continue to monitor progress and provide further updates as construction advances.

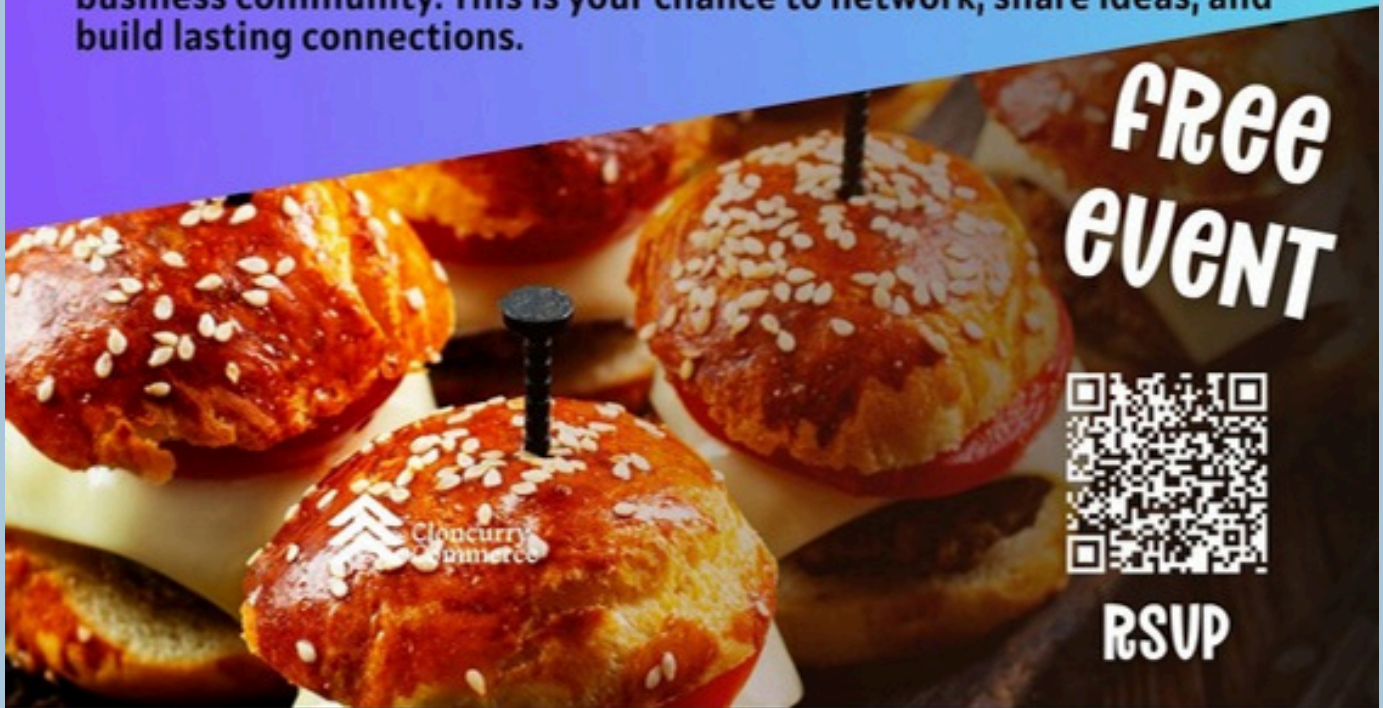

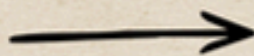

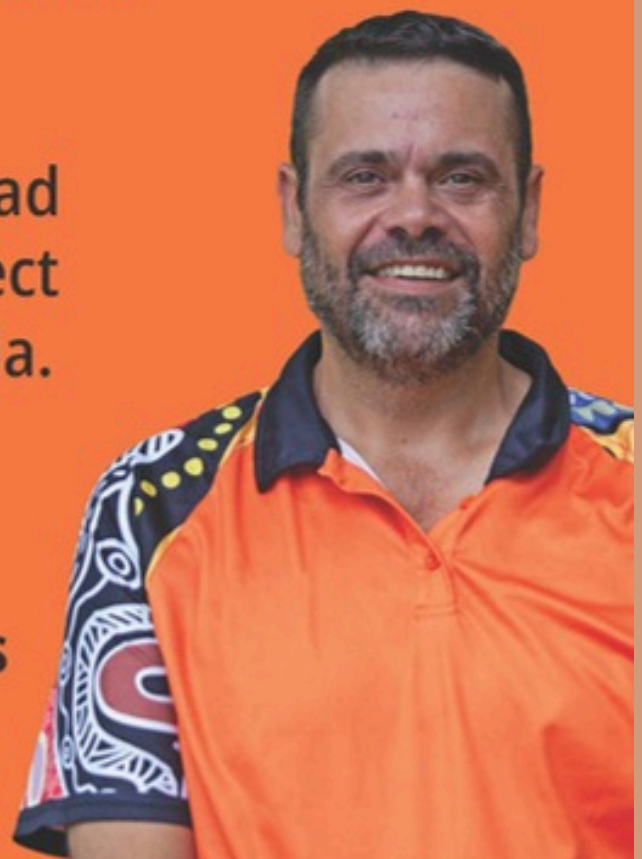
