## Proposal To Amend Subordinate Local Law No. 3

Cloncurry Shire Council (Council) is proposing to amend its current Subordinate Local Law No. 3 (Community & Environmental Management) 2014.

### Reason for Amendment

Cloncurry township is experiencing a significant outbreak of Leucaena. Leucaena is not designated as a restricted or prohibited species in the Regional Biosecurity Plan or the legislation from which it is derived. Declaring Leucaena as a local pest in Council's Local Law enables Council to intervene in Leucaena outbreaks, particularly on land not controlled by Council.

### Community Feedback

Council welcomes the community's feedback on this proposed amendment. Written submissions are invited for a 21-day period, commencing on Friday, 10 November 2023.
