Cloncurry Shire Council (Council) is proposing to amend its current Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2014.

Reason for Amendment

Council is extending its footpath and cycle path network within Cloncurry township. There have been numerous instances where motorbikes and quad bikes have been sighted on new pathways. Council has concluded this activity poses a safety risk to the public and will likely damage infrastructure.
