Coppermine Creek Bridge Replacement PEDESTRIAN ACCESS CLOSED 4 DECEMBER 2024

Cloncurry Shire Council wishes to advise that **pedestrian access across Coppermine Creek is temporarily closed due to flooding from rain overnight**. Council is working to clean up the site. Once the water recedes and the crossing is deemed safe to use, Council will reissue an updated notice.

While works are in process, the following changes to road conditions will be implemented.

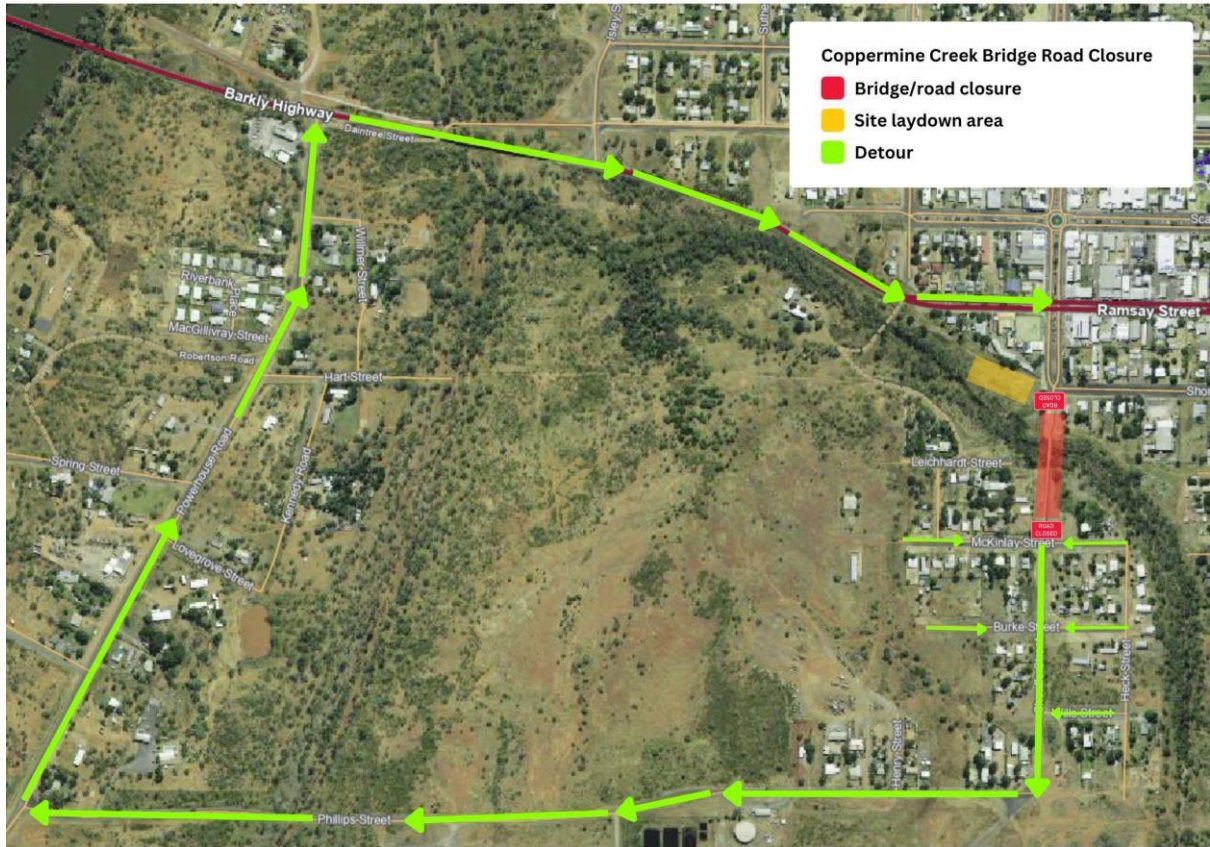


Figure 1: Coppermine Creek Bridge closure remains in place 20 November 2024 – 30 June 2025
