Cloncurry Cattle Rail Load Out Project Works Change in Traffic Conditions

Cloncurry Shire Council wishes to advise that Cloncurry Cattle Rail Load Out project works are due to commence on Wednesday, 24 April 2024.

The project involves the demolition and replacement of the existing Cattle Rail Load Out Facility.

During the project works, the following changed traffic conditions will be in place:

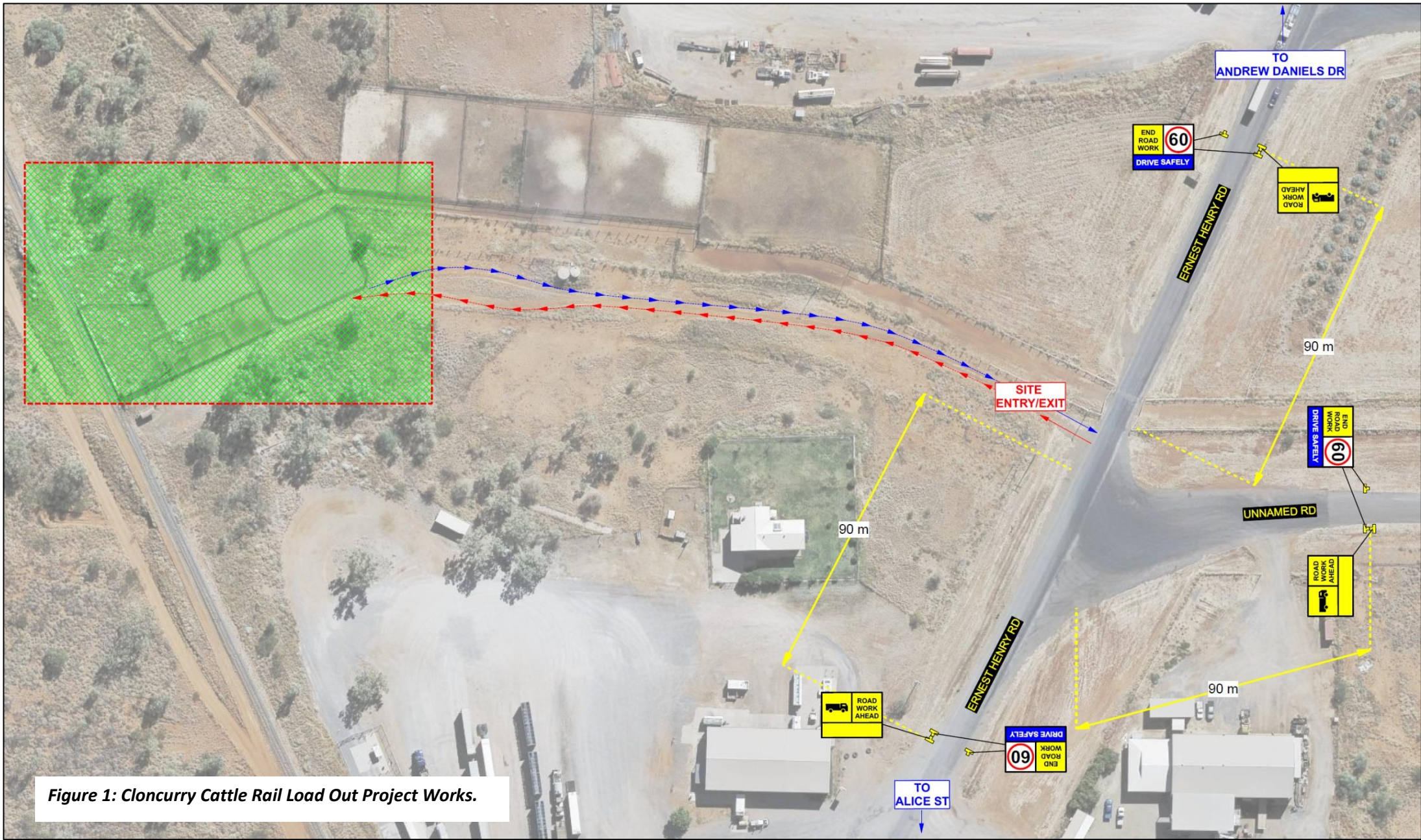


Figure 1: Cloncurry Cattle Rail Load Out Project Works.

24 April 2024 – 25 July 2024	Sir Hudson Fysh Drive (Between IOR and RTA depot. See Figure 1)	Open to all traffic. Changes to vehicle and pedestrian access within the works area. Please be mindful of and follow all Construction and Traffic Management signage and directions.
