Coppermine Creek Bridge Replacement **BRIDGE CLOSING 10 October 2024**

Cloncurry Shire Council wishes to advise that the **Coppermine Creek Bridge will be closed from 7:00am Thursday, 10 October 2024**. Preliminary works are now complete, and contractors will be moving on to the construction stage of the project.

While works are in process, the following changes to road conditions will be implemented.

DATE	ROAD/ASSETS IMPACTED	IMPACTS

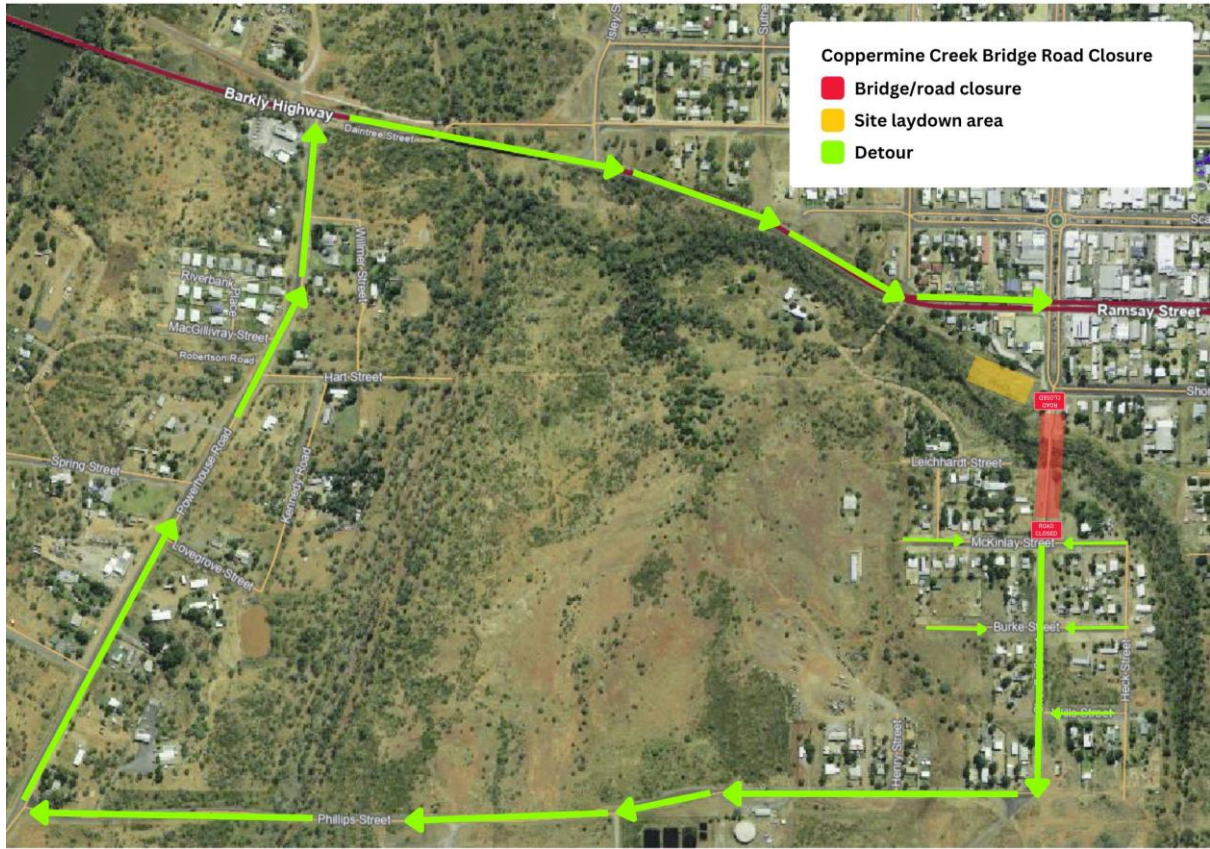


Figure 1: Coppermine Creek Bridge closure 10 October 2024 – 30 June 2025

10 October 2024 – 30 June 2025	Coppermine Creek Bridge (Sheaffe Street)	Coppermine Creek Bridge closed to all traffic. <u>Vehicles</u> Access to the southern side of the bridge will be accessible via Powerhouse Road and Phillips Street. <u>Pedestrians</u> Pedestrians will still be able to cross the creek, initially via the current bridge and later by a temporary access bridge. Follow all construction and traffic management signage. Refer to Figure 1.

Work hours will be 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday and 7:00am to 4:00pm on Saturday. Work will not take place on Sunday or public holidays.

Council appreciates your patience and understanding during this project and thanks you for your cooperation during the construction phase. Council will continue to provide updates throughout this project.
