## Coppermine Creek Bridge Replacement DEMOLITION WORKS 23 NOVEMBER 2024

Cloncurry Shire Council wishes to advise that Demolition Works on Coppermine Creek Bridge will commence 7:00am Saturday, 23 November 2024. Preliminary works are now complete, and contractors will be moving on to the construction stage of the project.

- **Coppermine Creek Bridge Demolition: 23 November – 1 December 2024**

Contractors have dust and noise control measures in place and anticipate the demolition of the old bridge will have minimal impact on nearby residents and businesses. An excavator will be used to break the bridge into sections. Contractors expect some noise while using the rock breaker and loading trucks.

Work hours for the bridge demolition will be 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday and 7:00am to 4:00pm Saturday and Sunday.

While works are in process, the following changes to road conditions will be implemented.

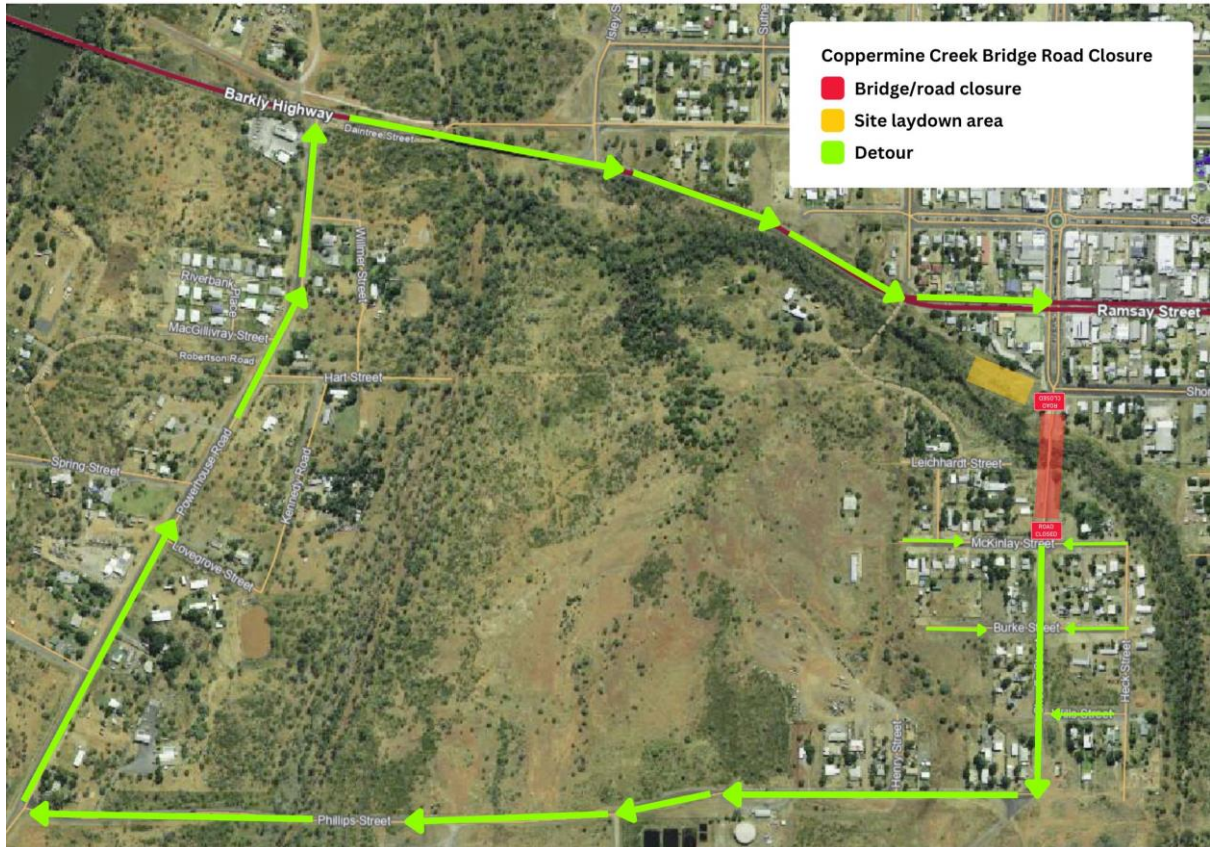


Figure 1: Coppermine Creek Bridge closure 10 October 2024 – 30 June 2025

10 October 2024 – 30 June 2025	<b>Coppermine Creek Bridge</b>  (Sheaffe Street)	<b>Coppermine Creek Bridge closed to all traffic.</b>  <b><u>Vehicles:</u></b> Access to the southern side of the bridge will be accessible via Powerhouse Road and Phillips Street.  <b><u>Pedestrians:</u></b> Pedestrians will still be able to cross the creek, initially via the current bridge and later by a temporary access bridge. Follow all construction and traffic management signage.  Refer to Figure 1.

Council appreciates your patience and understanding during this project and thanks you for your cooperation during the construction phase. Council will continue to provide updates throughout this project.
