Cloncurry Bushfire Update 2:30pm 28 October 2024

Queensland Fire Department – Warning Level

The Queensland Fire Department has pulled back the Advice Warning for Cloncurry and there is currently no bushfire warning for Cloncurry.

Total Fire Ban

A total fire ban remains in place for the Cloncurry Shire until midnight Thursday, 31 October 2024.

Continued Monitoring

While the Queensland Fire Department and local crews will continue to monitor and manage fires locally, the downgraded warning level from the department and Local Disaster Management Group reflects a reduced requirement for cross-agency coordination and response. External resources will start to be redeployed to other fires around the State.
