



PUBLIC NOTICE

Water Meter Replacement and Installation 29 August 2024 – 27 September 2024

Cloncurry Shire Council wishes to advise that work has begun on a town-wide water meter replacement and installation project. Select properties have been identified as having either an unserviceable water meter or no water meter. Ratepayers of these properties have been directly contacted.

Work Schedule

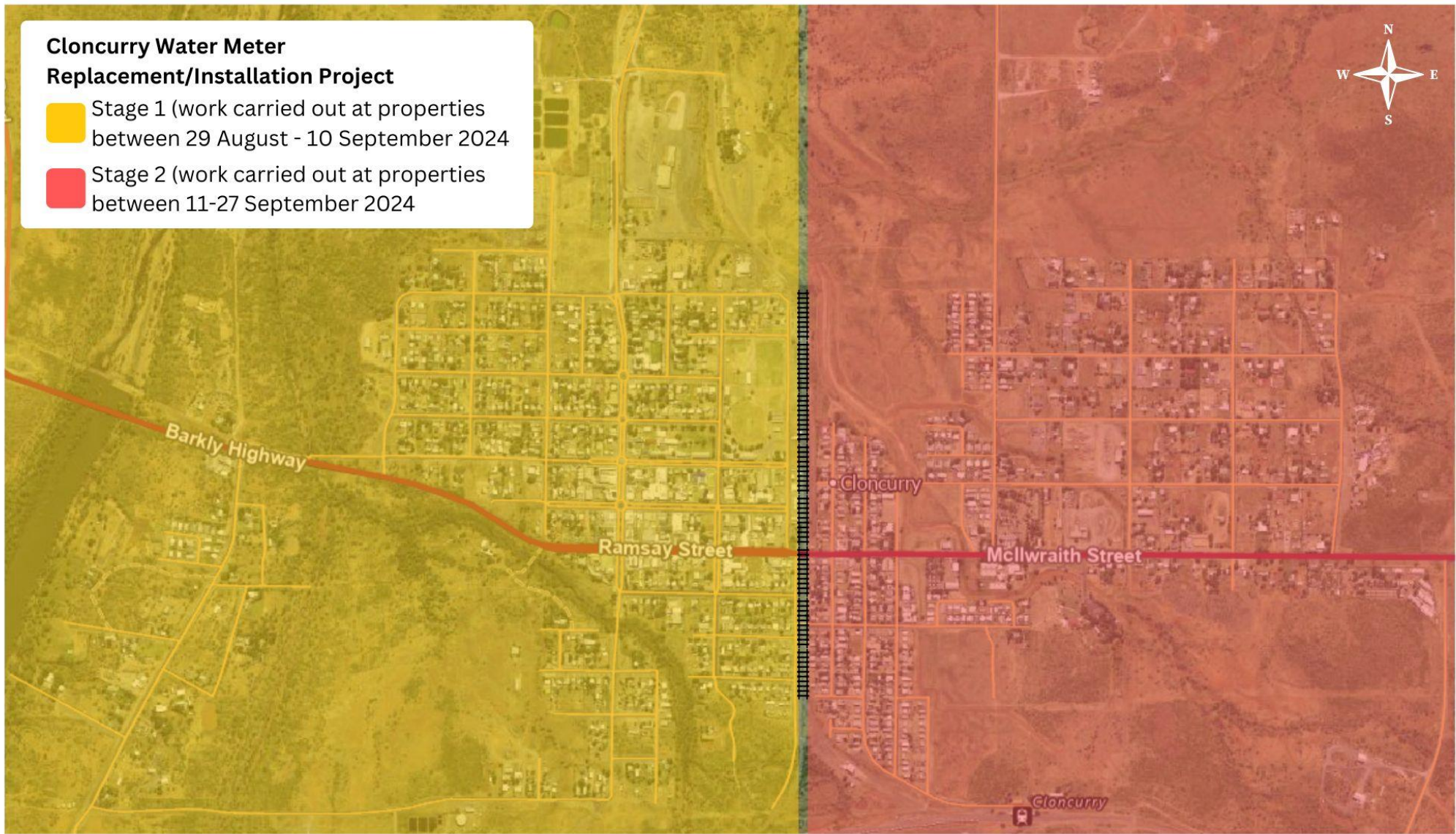


Figure 1: Project works will be carried out in two stages.

Properties on the western side of the railway line can expect contractors onsite anywhere between 29 August 2024 and 10 September 2024. **Properties on the eastern side of the railway line** can expect contractors onsite anywhere between 11 and 27 September 2024. See Figure 1. Work will be between 8:00am and 5:00pm, Monday to Friday.

Project Impacts

Contractors will need to access the water meter, which may be inside the property fence.

If the contractors cannot access the water meter when they visit, they will leave a notice to contact Council so a suitable time can be arranged to revisit the property and install the water meter.

Replacing the water meter at your property will be quick and have minimal impacts. Once the contractor is on-site, it should take no longer than 30 minutes to replace the meter. The property may lose water but for no more than 30 minutes. If the contractor can see there are people at the property, they will make contact before shutting the water off.
