Re-commencement of works

Coppermine Creek Bridge

Cloncurry Shire Council wishes to advise that works will re-commence at **Coppermine Creek Bridge on the 13 January 2025**.

Piling works have commenced and contractors will be continuing with construction stages of the bridge.

While works are in process, the following changes to road conditions will be implemented.

DATE	ROAD/ASSETS IMPACTED	IMPACTS

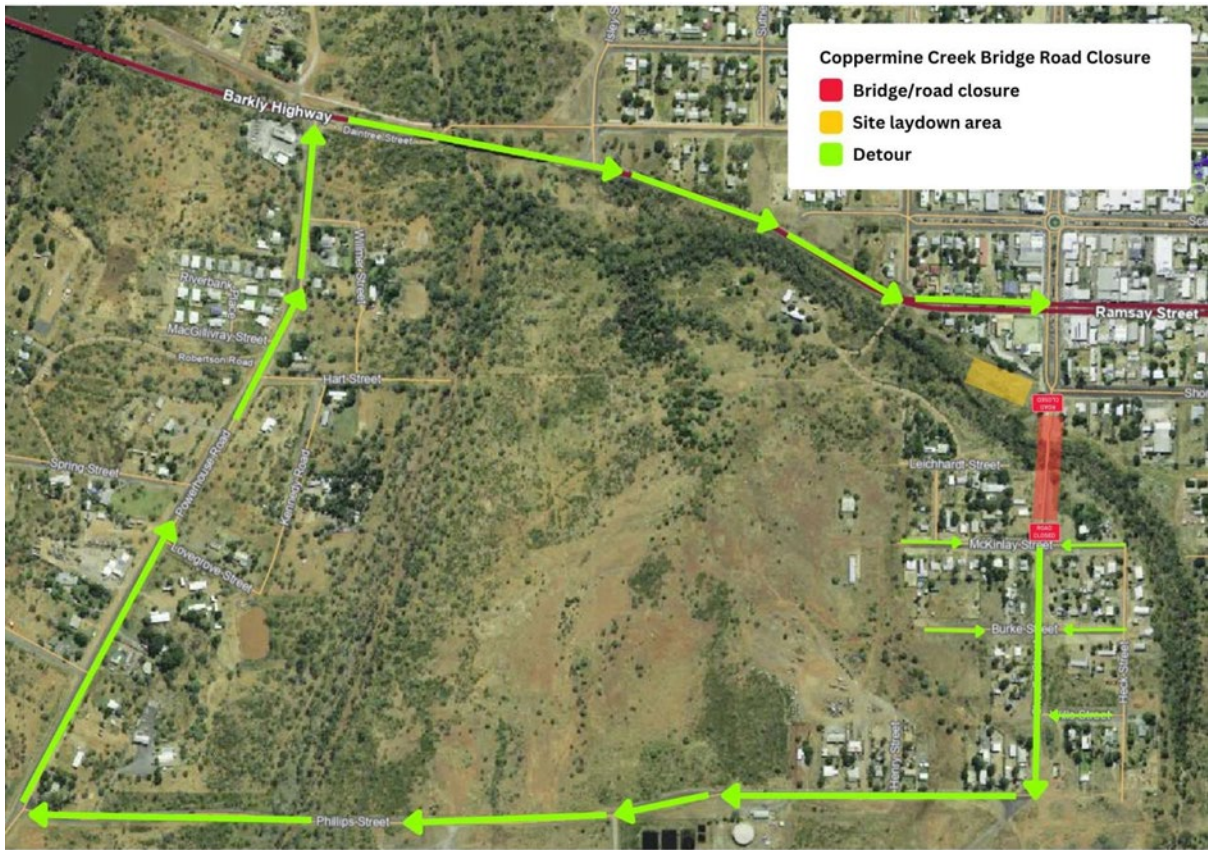


Figure 1: Coppermine Creek Bridge closure 10 October 2024 – 30 June 2025

10 October 2024 – 30 June 2025	Coppermine Creek Bridge (Sheaffe Street)	Coppermine Creek Bridge closed to all traffic. <u>Vehicles</u> Access to the southern side of the bridge will be accessible via Powerhouse Road and Phillips Street. <u>Pedestrians</u> Pedestrians will still be able to cross the creek, initially via the current bridge and later by a temporary access bridge. Follow all construction and traffic management signage. Refer to Figure 1.

Work hours will be **7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday** and **7:00am to 4:00pm on Saturday and Sunday**. There will be no work on 26-27 January 2025.
