Sir Hudson Fysh Drive Project Road Closure until 22 July 2022

Cloncurry Shire Council wish to advise that works on the Sir Hudson Fysh Drive Project will continue until 22 July 2022.

While the project has come in under budget, we need an extra week to finish off the last stages of the Project.

The project involves widening and reconstructing the existing road formation to improve safety for all road users, construction of cemetery car-parking and extension of cycle paths along Sir Hudson Fysh Drive.

During the project works, the following changes to road conditions will be implemented:

Date	Roads/Assets Impacted	Road conditions

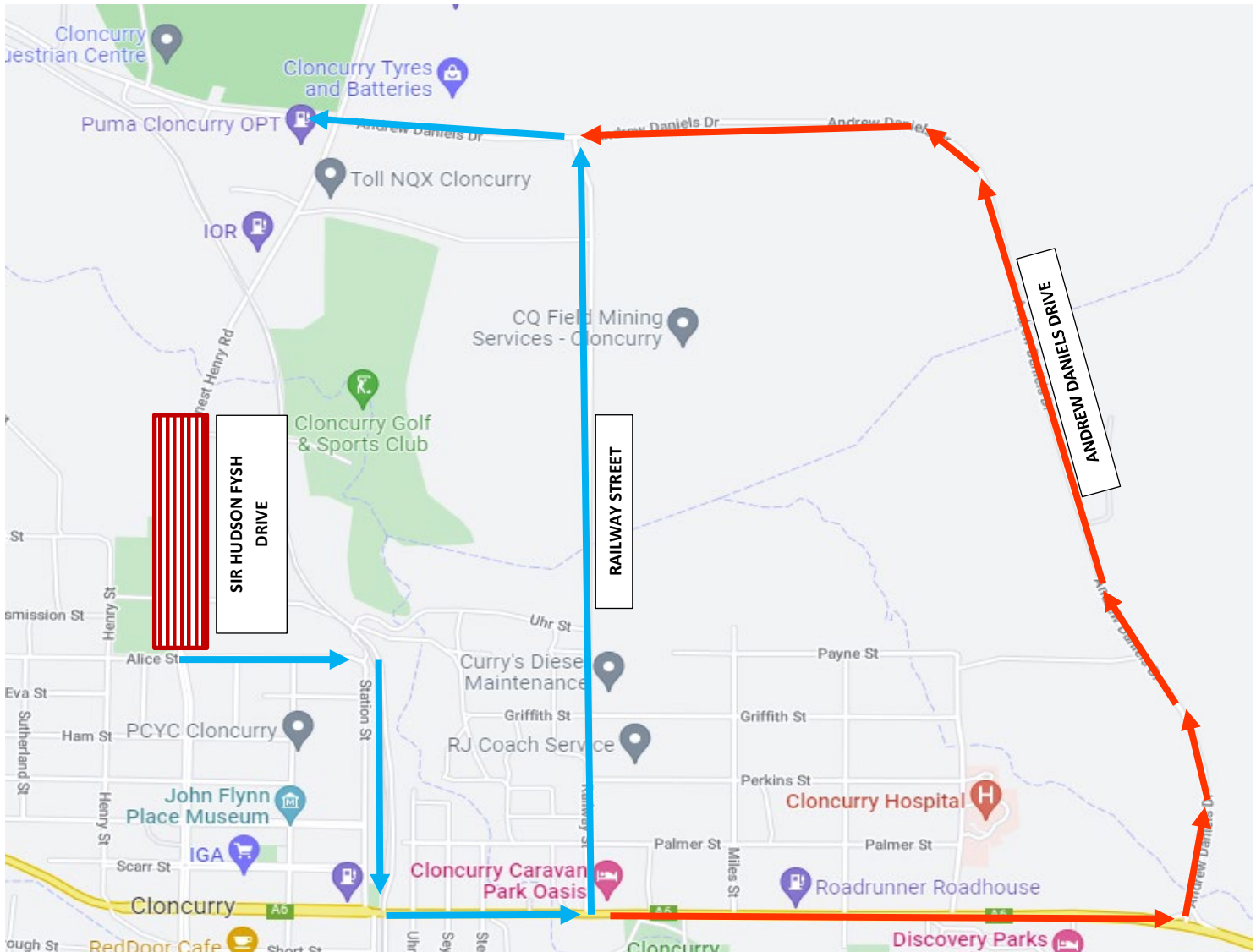


Figure 1: Sir Hudson Fysh Drive Road Closure 4 May 2022 – 15 July 2022

4 May 2022 – 15 July 2022	Sir Hudson Fysh Drive (Between Carl Katter Bridge and Alice Street)	Closed to traffic except for emergency services and local businesses or residents who enter their properties within the Works Area. Refer to Figure 1.
	Carl Katter Bridge	Carl Katter Bridge will need to be closed for part of the Works . Timeframe to be confirmed and notice will be given before closure.
	Cemetery	Where Works restrict access to the Cemetery, alternative access will be via Henry Street and details will be shared via a Public Notice.

Works will be from 6:00am – 6:00pm, Monday – Friday; from 6:30am – 6:00pm, Saturday and Sunday works will be scheduled from 7:00am – 5:30pm. During this time machinery or works noise could impact local businesses and residences.
